A special one-hour edition of Tri-Valley Mayor’s Report, taped on location at the Martinelli Event Center at Garre Vineyard and Winery in Livermore, will begin airing on Channel 30 on Monday, November 22. Mayors from the cities of Dublin, Livermore, Pleasanton, and San Ramon will discuss topical issues relating to the Tri-Valley. The show, which will run for two weeks, will air Monday – Friday at 8 a.m., 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

“Twice a year, we have the all the Mayor’s on the set together to focus on issues relating to the cities in the Tri-Valley,” said host/producer, Carolyn Siegfried. “Among the topics that are discussed include election results, the impact of the passage of various propositions and measures that have an effect on the Tri-Valley as well updates about transportation projects and funding. There is a lot going on in the 580/680 corridor,” Siegfried added.
